

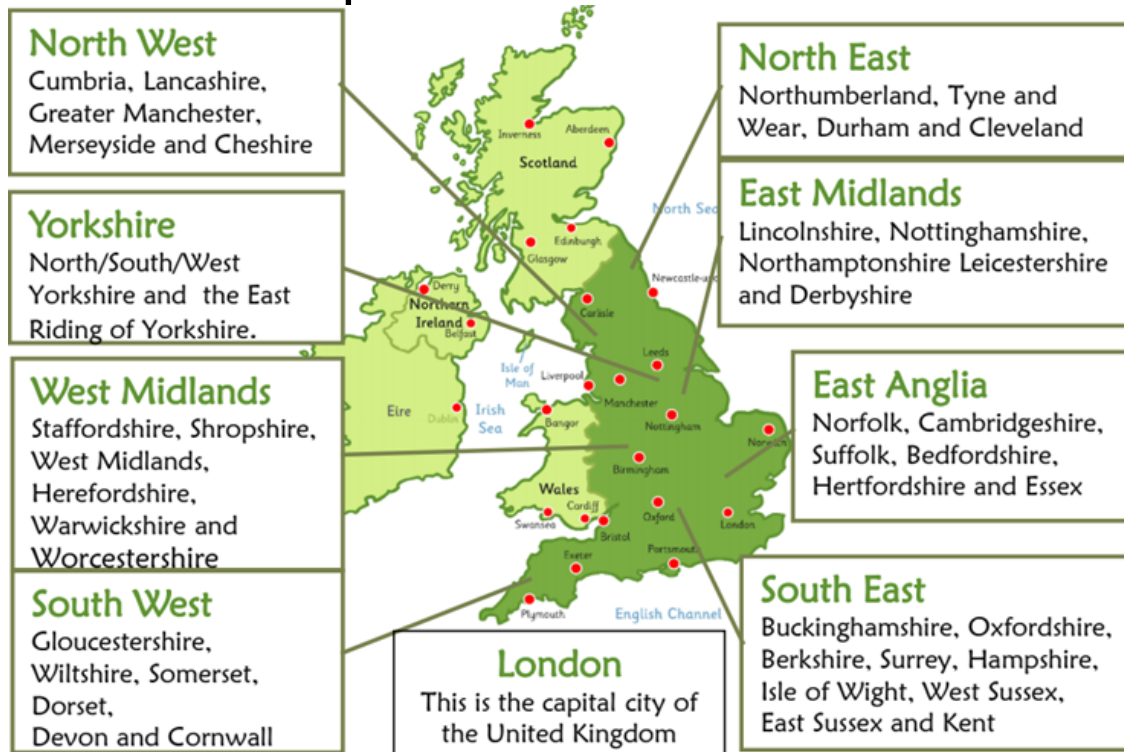

Things everyone needs to know

- Mount Everest is the worlds highest mountain at 8,850m
- Mountains can be rocky and barren; some have plants growing on them and very high mountains have snow on them.
- Some mountains are under the sea
- Mountains are over 600m otherwise they're classed as hills
- The highest 14 mountains in the world are all in the Himalayas
- 80% of our fresh water originates from mountains
- The highest mountain in the UK is in Scotland: Ben Nevis 1345m
